Through the various business activities of infection control at livestock sites ahead of the industry, we supported the formation of a culture that regards pets as family members and considers Japanese food to be safe and secure, which has become a shared understanding.

Pet area



Support for rehoming activities of rescue dogs/cats

To eliminate the euthanasia of dogs and cats, we operate Veterinary Adoption, an adoption website for the rehoming of rescue dogs and cats in cooperation with veterinary clinics across Japan. This website also cooperates with municipal governments and veterinary medical associations.



Promotion of microchipping

We encourage microchips for pet identification. We endeavor to decrease the number of unfortunate animals through comprehensive activities of providing information on the necessity of microchipping, implantation of microchips, and registration service.



Prevention of diseases

We provide a portfolio of high-quality vaccines developed and manufactured by our company or imported from overseas. Our efforts to prevent diseases include the provision of anthelminthics to repel parasitic fleas and ticks, as well as preventives for filaria, parasitic heartworms in the heart and pulmonary artery.



Diagnosis and treatment of diseases

We provide a variety of drugs to veterinary clinics, including therapeutic drugs for cardiovascular, gastrointestinal, dermal, and endocrine diseases, as well as antibacterial medication. We also handle test kits to help in the diagnosis of diseases, thereby supporting the provision of more enhanced animal healthcare service.



Support for veterinary clinics and veterinarians

We operate the Small Animal Clinic (SAC) Navi to provide academic and technical information to clinical veterinarians for small animals. In addition, we sponsor seminars by veterinarians, report cases, and share useful information, such as e-learning articles.



Reduction of pet owners' burden from vet visits

We operate KS Online, where customers can purchase products online from veterinary hospitals, such as veterinarian-recommended supplements and care products. We will contribute to the further improvement of pet health by reducing the owners' burden from vet visits.



Health management and aging care

We provide dietic food, supplements, dental care, and skin care products. Because long-term care is becoming increasingly important for aged pets, we promote long-term care products for veterinary clinics.

Livestock and aquaculture area



Infection prevention

We provide vaccines for cattle, swine, poultry, and cultured fish. We have an approximately 80% market share in Japan, especially in vaccines for cultured fish. We contribute to stable aquaculture production.



Provision of veterinary medicines and Feed Feed Additives

We provide veterinary medicines and Feed · Feed Additives to support producers, including hormonal agents, antibacterial medicine, gastrointestinal agents, antipyretics and analgesics, and vitamin preparations.



Solutions to all problems of producers

We pursue comprehensive solutions in cooperation with different firms, organizations, and administrative agencies to a wide range of problems faced by production farms in breeding management, hygiene control, and the livestock environment (such as odor, wild animals, and manure processing).



Support for hygienic environment

We promote the dissemination of the HACCP* system to support the improved safety of livestock and aquaculture animals and products. We also support epidemic control and public health improvement of production sites.

*Stands for Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point; a hygiene control method to ensure food safety.



Information for producers

We operate Chikusan (livestock) Navi, online media that provides useful information for production sites in a plain and specific manner under the concept of delivering information to the future livestock industry.





Core Competence of Kyoritsu Seiyaku

Kyoritsu Seiyaku has accumulated achievements and a reputation for reliability since its foundation.

This section provides a snapshot of the featured strengths of Kyoritsu Seiyaku.



Importing the first canine distemper vaccine into Japan

In 1955, we imported the first canine distemper vaccine into Japan from the Netherlands. We have continued to import and market high-quality vaccines and veterinary medicines, thereby linking the overseas and Japanese markets.



Releasing the first aquaculture vaccine in Japan

We developed a vaccine to reduce loss by disease in cultured yellowtail. We released and disseminated the first aquaculture vaccine in Japan throughout the aquaculture industry ahead of other companies.



Starting the first 100% microchipping of auctioned pets in the industry

In 2019, the Act on the Welfare and Management of Animals was amended to require microchipping and registration by breeders of dogs and cats. In response, we started the 100% prior microchipping of auctioned pets, which account for approximately 70% of traded live dogs and cats.



Starting support for HACCP introduction

To enhance food safety and security, we took a leadership role to introduce the HACCP* system in the industry so that the integrated hygiene control from production to manufacturing and shipment to be carried out. Our comprehensive service includes support for livestock farmers to gain a certification and offering solutions to the various problems that face production sites, including odor and manure processing.

Marketing the only mastitis vaccine approved in Japan

We imported the vaccine from Spain in 2009 and marketed it in 2016. Among the pathogenic bacteria that cause mastitis, this vaccine caters to three out of the four main bacteria and alleviates symptoms when mastitis develops.



Providing a broad product portfolio of approx. 2,000 items

We provide a product portfolio of approximately 2,000 items, including vaccines, veterinary medicines, dietic food, supplements, long-term care products, feed, and medical devices.

Maintaining steady sales since the foundation

We began the import of veterinary medicines in the early post-WWII era and commenced in-house development and manufacturing in the 1960s. Our business operations have diversified by entering fields other than veterinary medicines. Owing to this foresight, Kyoritsu Seiyaku has maintained steady sales since its foundation.



President's Message

Since our foundation in 1955, our business activities have focused on animal healthcare, including the provision of drugs and hygiene control at the production sites. Because the business environment surrounding us continues to change, our mission is also definitely changing.

In this context, we have determined that our mission is *Creating the future for humans and animals* as we take a new step forward. In addition to the research, development, manufacture, and marketing of drugs as conventional tasks, we are facing the diseases that are difficult to prevent or treat at present. We have a large number of problems, such as the health problems of aged pets in the pet area and countermeasures for classical swine fever and avian influenza in the livestock and aquaculture area. We not only cope with these problems but also promote business activities that foresee possible changes in the future.


